The EAC will then make corrections to the Program Policies and Procedures to improve the quality of the Program.

Actions to be taken by the Program where areas of the Assessment Plan are not met include:

- 1. Review courses in areas of deficiency and modify as needed.
- 2. Review cognitive, psychomotor and affective experiences that correlate to the individual items that were less than the stated standard and modify as necessary.
- 3. Review teaching and learning strategies and revise as necessary.
- 4. Review individual instructor's deficiencies in meeting minimum clinical and didactic requirements and intervene with remediation.
- 5. Review activities that discourage students from participation and make appropriate changes to increase participation.

Since each cohort of students is relatively small, it may be necessary to monitor changes in the Assessment Plan over several years to determine an effective corrective action.
