Students will be oriented to the health care environment prior to clinical assignments. A variety of orientation mechanisms are utilized including but not limited to:

1. Students entering the Program will attend the first available Regional West Health Services employee orientation program and complete required online training and testing.
2. Complete review of Program policies in course 200 Introduction to Technology course.
3. Complete the basic patient care portion in course 210 Patient Care course.
4. Complete a Basic Life Support (CPR & AED) course.
5. Complete student orientation program as required by Banner Health for clinical rotations in Torrington.
6. Complete student orientation program as required by Box Butte General Hospital for clinical rotations in Alliance.
7. Complete student orientation program as required by Morrill County Community Hospital for clinical rotations in Bridgeport.
8. Complete imaging department specific orientation at all clinical education settings as applicable

9. Complete the MRI safety instruction and MRI screening form.
